RUS (Rural Utilities Service) acceptance and "Buy American" status are required for service providers who request federal funds from the Broadband Initiative program (BIP), which is part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), for the purpose of purchasing and deploying broadband systems.

RADWIN 2000 is widely deployed throughout the US by leading tier-1 service providers and cellular carriers for applications such as Cellular and IP backhaul and broadband access. The sub-6 GHz radios present a new level of reliability and ease of installation, delivering high capacity of up to 100 Mbps and long range of up to 75 miles, with advanced technologies such as OFDM and MIMO inside.
